



- What is it?** A 6 night trip to Budapest, Bratislava and Vienna
- Who is it for?** Rangers and Young Leaders with a date of birth between 13th August 2008 and 12th August 2013
- When is it?** 6th - 12th August 2027
- Who are the leaders?** The trip will be led by Helen Salvini, Mel Price and Amy Mackin. All three have led similar trips over the past 10 years as well as having travelled independently.
- How will I meet everyone?** There will be at least 3 briefing events when everyone can get to know each other. We will also meet up for fundraising activities.
- Where will we stay?** We will be staying for 3 nights in Budapest and 3 nights in Bratislava (from where we will take a day trip to Vienna). We will be staying in hostels, apartments or hotels (this will be confirmed nearer the time but all accommodation will be suitable for young people with private bathrooms)
- Why should you come?** Budapest, Bratislava and Vienna are all beautiful cities to explore. Whilst in Budapest we will be participating in "Adventures in Budapest" which is a Girlguiding North West England event where hundreds of Brownies, Guides, Rangers, Young Leaders and Leaders will participate in a giant treasure hunt game across the city on the same day (7th August). There is a long history of these events and they are always fantastic! Beyond that you will have the chance to get to know new people, experience independent travel, have a say in planning the event, help to budget and fundraise.
- What will it cost?** The trip is expected to cost approximately £1,250 depending on final travel and insurance costs. This will include all travel (flights from Manchester), insurance, accommodation, all food and activities as well as an international Guiding necker and all the briefing sessions. It does not include the cost of a passport (if you do not already have one) or personal spending money. To keep costs for participants down, leaders will pay the same amount.
- We don't want anyone to be put off by cost. Individual grants are available so if you would like to discuss this please contact us directly and confidentially.

We plan to fundraise towards the cost of the trip and will offer as many fundraising opportunities as we can. We encourage girls to do their own on top of this and we would really encourage and support this. Funds raised collectively will be allocated based on participation so it is really important to engage to keep your payments down.

You can pay any additional amount at any time so the earlier you book the earlier you can start fundraising and making payments to spread the cost and the earlier we can apply for grants to help you.

Payments will be needed as follows:

31st July £100

1st September £150

1st October - 1st Jul £100 per month (10 payments in total)

Any of the payments can be made by fundraising, gifts from family (e.g. birthdays and Christmas) or by a regular standing order.
